 - b. Community Leader
- 9. Must be resident of Scott County, Virginia
- **Remember, submit the following to your Guidance Counselor no later than **Monday, April 7th, 2020**
 - 1. Completed application
 - 2. Two letters of reference
 - 3. Copy of Student Aid Report (SAR) from FAFSA (can be found and printed online)
 - 4. One-page essay (refer to number 7 above)

The counselor will submit your completed application, along with your transcript, to a representative of the Scott County College Fund Board of Directors.

The Scott County College Fund Board of Directors will consider only those applications that are complete in every detail.

The scholarship is in the amount of \$2,500.00. Up to two (2) recipients may be named at each high school in Scott County for the 2019-20 academic year. Scholarship recipients will be announced on Senior Awards Day.

This scholarship will be paid to the student in the amount of \$1,250.00 for the first semester upon proof of enrollment from the college. The remaining amount of \$1,250.00 will be paid to the student at the beginning of the second semester upon confirmation that the student is still enrolled at the school, a minimum 2.0 GPA is met, required course work is complete, and student has maintained good moral character.
