Spotlight into the classrooms:

English 8 - Mrs. Jaramillo - We are focusing on essay writing with prompts in relation to historical articles found on CommonLit. We have also been working on pronoun/antecedent agreement as well as parallelism in writing.

Pre-Algebra - Mr. Cassel - Students are learning how to identify, graph, and solve for the slope of a line.

Math 8 - Mrs. Flanary - Math 8 we are solving two step equations

Science 8 - Dr. Collier - Our class is learning how to convert temperatures to Kelvin, Fahrenheit, and degrees Celsius.

Digital Apps - Mrs. Gillenwater - New students this semester are learning to touch-type using the home row keys without looking at their hands using Edutyping.com. Students are also working on Digital Art projects in Google Drawing. The winning digital drawings this week after students anonymously voted were Nalaya and Bryce S. (see attached on page 4).

Earth Science * Career Investigation * Environmental Science - Mrs. A. Addington - Environmental Science and Earth Science started out the year learning about Scientific Investigation. During our virtual days, we learned about the importance of not littering. Now, Earth Science is learning about Maps and will continue on with Minerals and Rocks afterward. Environmental Science is learning about Classification and Dichotomous Keys. We're going to learn how to make a dichotomous key using students' shoes.

Career Investigation started out learning about Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources. We did an edible lab on Soil Layers, and we planted seeds (but the snow prevented us from getting to water them). Now Career Investigation is learning about Architecture and Construction. They'll be drawing a floor plan and a landscape architecture plan. Then they will construct a paper house and a paper volcano model.

Earth Science, Environmental Science, and Career Investigation all had a special guest this month. Brittany Castle, TSHS Alumnus, Class of 2011, travelled from Hawaii to teach the students about Sustainable Agriculture and what types of jobs are available for animal and plant science. She had each group do an activity where they had to plan out a farm. Brittany is working on her Doctorate in Animal Science at University of Hawaii at Manoa. She also teaches at the University.

World History - Mr. George - Students are learning about the ancient civilizations.

Art I - Mrs. Keith -We have started this semester studying the 7 elements of Art. So far we have covered Line, Shape, and Texture.
