### Spotlight into the classrooms:

**Pre-Algebra** - Mr. Cassel - Students are using MasteryConnect to review previous material and remediate where necessary. Current topics include Surface Area and Volume of solids.

Math 8 - Mrs. Flanary - Students are working on learning volume of rectangular prisms and volume of cylinders. Soon we'll be learning surface area of 3 dimensional figures.

**Science 8** - Dr. Collier - In Science 8, we just completed our unit on matter. We discussed chemical and physical properties and changes, states of matter, and changes of state. In the next week, we will be covering atomic structure, the periodic table, and periodic trends.

Digital Apps - Mrs. Gillenwater - In Digital Apps class students are learning to correctly format MLA research papers with in-line parenthetical citations and works cited reference pages. Students are learning to create flyers, news releases, and tables in Microsoft Word.

FACS - Mrs. S. Addington Class has been in the kitchen with Ms. Berry with our 4H Nutrition program. They all loved the food they made.

Life Skills - Mr. Burke - Our class has started working on narrowing down career choices. We are also about to start a car maintenance chapter, and will be learning how to change a tire, how to check fluids, and what to do if your car breaks down.

Earth Science - A. Addington - Career Investigation \* Environmental Science - Mrs. A. Addington - Earth Science has been learning about geology. They got to test some Minerals to figure out which ones they were. They also got to do a lab on Rock identification. During the Rock and Fossil Record unit, we do a "Kindergarten Day," where the students get to cut, color, and pastel. On that day, they made a Fossil Timeline, a Trilobite model, and an optional extra credit Nautiloid model. Now, they will start with Astronomy in anticipation of the upcoming Solar Eclipse on April al

Career Investigation - A. Addington - Career Investigation has been focusing on the Business Management and Administration career cluster. We've learned about several careers in that cluster, and have practiced some very valuable skills. Those skills include writing their address, addressing an envelope, learning cursive letters, practicing their name in cursive, practicing THEIR signature, writing a check, endorsing a check, writing a business letter, and learning to type the correct way. We've had to practice several of these skills multiple times. Our next career cluster will be Education and Training.

Environmental Science - A. Addington - Environmental Science has learned about several predatory birds, what Buzzards really are and where they live (not in the USA), and now they are learning about critters in the creek, like mussels and other macroinvertebrates. We plan to get in the creek and gather macroinvertebrates to see what our water quality is. We're thankful for the beautiful weather we're having so we can have class outside!

Earth Science, Environmental Science, and Career Investigation all had a couple of guests at the beginning of March. Eastman sent a couple of representatives to teach about Engineers Week. Alicia Powers and Everett Shepherd are both former TSHS teachers and got to come back to tell the kids about what they do at Eastman, tell about engineering, and then lead an activity on building bridges. The students got to "purchase" items to build their bridges with and then construct them to hold a full 16 oz. water bottle. The students really enjoyed the activity, and we really appreciate the time Eastman allowed Alicia and Everett to have with our students.

**Spanish** I - Mr. Jaramillo - Spanish I is working on changing verbs to say who is doing something (verb conjugations) and will be discussing the Panama Canal. We are also are working on Locura de Marzo 2024 (music bracket competition)

### Spotlight into the classrooms:

Art I - Mrs. Keith - Art I classes are working on Perspective. Our projects will be an interior room drawn in I point perspective and a city block drawn in two point perspective. This will end our Elements of Design section and we will start studying famous artist during the 2nd 9 weeks.

English 9 - English 10 - English 11 - Mr. Shipley - Students in Honors English 9 have been working on some PSAT-SAT prep. English 11 students have been working to get ready to take the workkeys test coming up in this month.

English 9 - Mrs. Gilmer - We are finishing up Roald Dahl's 1953 short story Lamb to the Slaughter, a great piece to dig into literary elements such as perspective, theme, and irony, and the art of the literary analysis. The class also enjoyed watching Alfred Hitchcock's 1958 interpretation of the story.

**Spanish 2** - Mr. Jaramillo - Spanish 2 has been learning the past tense conjugations and will begin reading a novel. Students are working on Locura de Marzo 2024 (music bracket competition)

Spanish 3 - Mr. Jaramillo - Spanish 3 is working on a novel and reviewing the different verb tenses. We are also are working on Locura de Marzo 2024 (music bracket competition)

Algebra I - Mrs. Castle - We will finish up polynomials this week and start factoring next week.

Algebra 1 - Mrs. Flanary - we are adding and subtracting polynomials

Biology - Mr. Pierson - Students have learned the life cycle of a cell, the processes of cell reproduction, and how different types of cells reproduce. Students also observed cells under a microscope in various stages of cell division and sketched those. The class is getting ready to learn about bacteria and viruses. Students will learn their structure, function, how they cause disease, and how diseases are treated or prevented.

Biology 2 - Mr. Pierson - Students have learned different types of human bones, how bones develop, different types of bone fractures, how bones repair themselves, and factors that affect bone. The class is beginning to learn all the bones of the human skeleton. Students will learn the location and function of each human skeletal bone.

**English 10** - Mrs. Kopychenco - We are hard at work preparing for the Work Keys writing test, which we will take on March 13th. We continue to cover grammar and reading skills as we go.

Algebra 2 - Ms. Meadows - Students just finished Chapter 3 on solving systems of equations and inequalities. Now, they are learning about Radicals - how to simplify, add/subtract, multiply/divide, and solve radical equations.

Web Design - Mrs. Gillenwater - In Web Design class students are learning to use CSS cascading style sheets and HTML code to structure and style website content, hyperlinks, and graphics.

Chemistry I - Dr. Collier - In Chemistry I, we have been discussing atomic structure, subatomic particles, and historical models of the atom. We will be covering electron configurations, the quantum model of the atom, and quantum numbers in our upcoming unit.

Chemistry 11 - Dr. Collier - : In Chemistry 11, we have just completed our unit on thermodynamics and a lab on the chemistry of instant ice packs and calorimetry. Our current unit focuses on the kinetic molecular theory of the three primary states of matter.


